

To all Teams of the Pine Barren Creek Invitational Catfish Tournament:




The following are conclusions reached by Corp. of Engineers, as the water capacity May 14 – 20, 2007.

The graphs of fish activity were provided by experts from Auburn University.

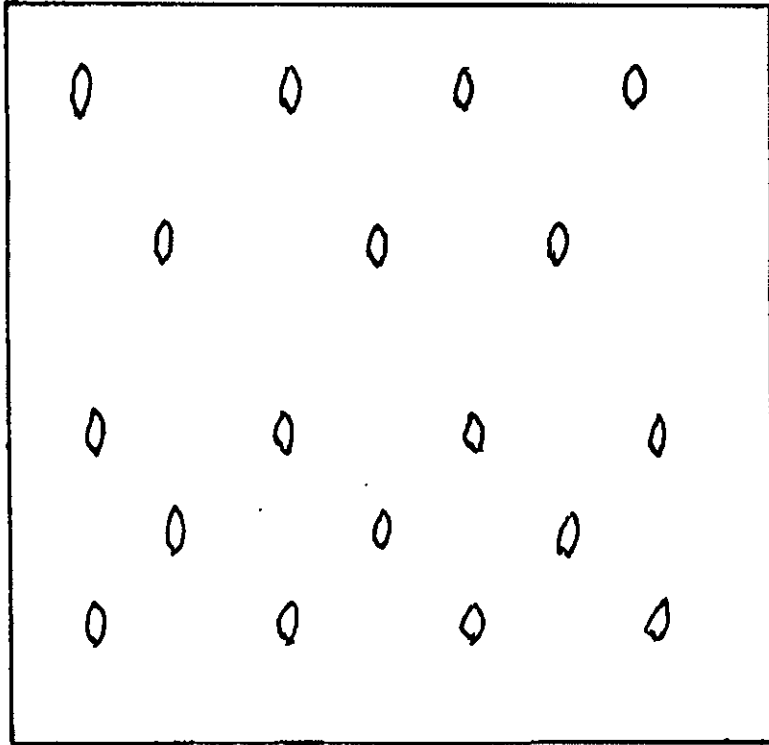
1. Corp. records will show that water capacity was at 50% between May 14 – 20, 2007.
2. Exhibit #2 attached, provided by Auburn University Experts on the effect a 50% pool would have on fish.
3. Auburn Experts were also asked to show on graph – Exhibit #2 attached – the effect on fish in the Dannelly Reservoir of Johnny Webb and Billy Johnson not fishing the past 2 years.

With the evidence provided, the judges have come to the conclusion that the old record still stands with a full pool. The record set May 19, 2007 is the record with a 50% pool and should be noted as such in any future conversations about this tournament

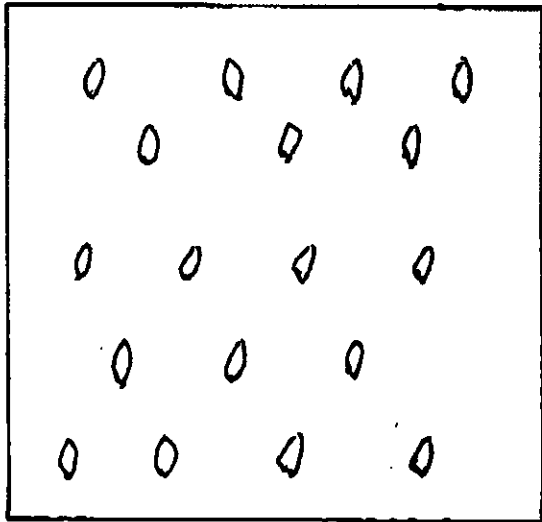
