Wilcox County is located in the heart of what has been called the "Golden Triangle for Trophy Bucks" By leading hunting authorities.

State conservation officials list Wilcox as having one of the largest deer herds in the state.

Wilcox Academy a six hundred plus member organization which promotes education within the county, annually sponsors this hunt to raise money for its general operating budget.

Guided by a member, you will hunt from a tree stand, or if you prefer from your own climbing stand. You and your guide will hunt on either wheat fields, soybean fields, food plots, hardwood bottoms, clear cuts or prime farm land.

The 2007 hunt brought in 103 total harvest; 63 bucks and 40 doe. The largest buck, a 9 point that weighed 198 lbs. was brought in by Doug Baxley. There were five 8pt., three 7 pt. and three 6pt. bucks scored. in 2008, we had a total of 100 deer brought in; 52 bucks and 48 doe. The largest deer by the WA scoring method of weight x points was 10 pt. that weighed 139 lbs. killed by Gary Jansen hunting with John Strother, 2nd was an 8 pt. weighing 167 lbs. taken by Anthony Margelis hunting with Philip Luker & Danny Stoudenmier. In 2009, we had 82 hunters that harvested 92 deer and 5 hogs. A good harvest considering the rain and lack of cold weather, Larry Gandy got the largest deer, a monster 10 pt. - that weighed 207 lbs. We also had 2 nine points, 6 eight points, and 4 seven points brought in. In 2010, 85 hunters braved low temperatures in the upper teens to kill 90 deer and 9 hogs, including a good number of wall hangers.

Please note: Registrations will be cut off at 90 hunters.


